Be it remembered the Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Tuesday, November 1, 2011, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting was called to order and prayer by the Mayor, and turned over to Alderman Wilson.

A motion was made by Alderman Sanders, duly seconded by Alderman Shook and unanimously approved the amended Agenda. A motion was made by Alderman Sanders, duly seconded by Alderman Taylor and unanimously approved the October minutes as read.

Jerry Yates met with the Board and presented his proposal for work for the town for the Fall and Winter Months of 2011-2012.

Galen Shumaker, Water Operator met with the Board and stated he had marked the water lines on Hwy 82, taking 13 days. He stated there was still one 6" lines cut. He also reported the pressure tank at the Booster station had collapsed, but did not know the reason for it. He has contacted the insurance company and an adjuster will come and inspect. He advised the board a claim would be filed.

He also reported the possibility of a school to be held in January for board members.

Because of some questions regarding the speed bumps on Lexington Street extended, the Board Clark talked with the company that sold the bumps and also talked with Mr. McCain with the Highway Department and both stated there was no code as to height of speed bumps.

Alderman Taylor reported the Fire Department is very appreciative of the Town wanting to have a supper for them, but requested it not be until January or February. He also stated he had talked with Donnie Perkins and it he cooked the cost per plate would be \$7.25.

A motion was made by Alderman Taylor, seconded by Alderman Sanders and approved for City Hall to be closed the same days as the Courthouse for Christmas.

The Board then discussed the proposal of Jerry Yates. A motion was made by Alderman Sanders, seconded by Alderman Lee and approved for Mr. Yates to do the work on his proposal one time (specifically the week before Thanksgiving) and the Town would make further decisions at the December, 2011 meetings.

A motion was made by Alderman Taylor, seconded by Alderman Sanders and approved to pay bills as read.

There being no further business to come before the Board a motion was made by Alderman Wilson, duly seconded by Alderman Sanders and approved to adjourn until Tuesday, December 6, 2011.
